



Membership Terms and Conditions

Effective Date: 25th May, 2026

By signing up with Accelerate Christian Home Schooling Support Services ("Accelerate", "we", "our", or "us"), you ("Member", "Parent", or "Family") agree to be bound by these Membership Subscription Terms and Conditions.

1. Membership Subscription Options

Membership fees may be paid by one of the following subscription options:

- Monthly (Australia and New Zealand only)
- Quarterly
- Semester
- Annual

The subscription option selected at the time of sign up will apply until changed by agreement between the Member and Accelerate.

2. Payment Authority

By signing up, you authorise Accelerate to automatically deduct membership fees from your nominated credit card, via Stripe, in advance of the applicable billing period.

You agree to maintain valid payment details and ensure sufficient funds are available for all scheduled payments.

3. Minimum Membership Term

New memberships are subject to a minimum commitment period of twelve (12) months from the date of sign up.

Where a Member selects to pay by monthly, quarterly, or semester instalments, this does not affect the minimum 12-month contractual commitment.

4. Early Cancellation During Minimum Term

If a Member chooses to cancel their membership before the completion of the initial 12-month term, the Member remains liable for all membership fees due for the remainder of that 12-month period.

Accelerate reserves the right to require payment of any outstanding balance upon cancellation.

5. Cancellation After Minimum Term

Following completion of the initial 12-month membership period, a Member may cancel their membership at any time by providing at least thirty (30) days' written notice to Accelerate.

Membership fees remain payable during the notice period (and to the end of the required payment period, if applicable).

6. Certificate Pathways

Members acknowledge that withdrawal or cancellation of membership will affect a child's eligibility to obtain a graduate certificate, resulting in the cancellation of their certificate pathway.

To remain eligible for a graduate certificate, membership must be maintained for the full duration of the completion of course PACE work through to the issuing of the certificate, being a minimum of twelve (12) months per certificate pathway.

Accelerate does not guarantee eligibility for certification where membership ceases before completion of the required coursework and final issuing of the graduate certificate.

7. Failed Payments

Where a scheduled payment is declined, dishonoured, reversed, or otherwise unsuccessful:

- a. Accelerate will suspend services until payment is received;
- b. A reinstatement fee will be charged before membership services are restored; and
- c. Accelerate will require immediate payment of outstanding membership fees, including any remaining balance owing as mentioned in Sections 3 and 4.

8. Non-Payment and Membership Termination

If an overdue payment remains unpaid for more than thirty (30) days after the due date, Accelerate will:

- Cancel the Member's membership;
- Suspend access to member services and benefits; and
- Cancel each child's certificate pathway, which will affect their eligibility to obtain the graduate certificate, from therein

Accelerate will make reasonable attempts to contact the Member regarding overdue amounts before taking further action to recover the amount still owing.

9. Membership Reinstatement

Where membership has been cancelled due to non-payment, reinstatement is at the sole discretion of Accelerate and may be subject to:

- Payment of all overdue/outstanding fees; and
- Payment of a reinstatement fee

10. Changes to Fees and Terms

Accelerate reserves the right to amend membership fees and these 'Terms and Conditions' from time to time.

Where changes are made, Accelerate will provide reasonable written notice to Members before the changes take effect.

Continued membership after the effective date of any amendment constitutes acceptance of the revised Terms and Conditions.

11. Refund Policy

All membership fees and initial sign up payments made to Accelerate are non-refundable once paid.

12. Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by the relevant laws. Any dispute arising in connection with these Terms and Conditions shall be subject to the applicable jurisdiction of the courts.

13. Acceptance

By submitting a membership form, selecting a membership subscription option, and making payment to Accelerate, the Member acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
